To All Arrows Parents and Guardians:

Please treat this letter, emailed to you by the Arrows or by your team general manager, as your official notification/instruction from the Arrows regarding the correct and only accepted procedure to request a release for your son/daughter should you be interested in doing so for the upcoming 2017-18 season. Email requests are not accepted. The release request process must be followed by all Arrows members, because its single purpose is to evidence that you have met your financial obligations to the Arrows. A release request will not be approved until you have met your financial obligation. Please note that it is a NYSAHA requirement that you must have an approved release request in hand in order to participate in any other organization's clinics/sessions between now and tryouts. Furthermore, your son/daughter cannot attend an other organization's tryouts without presenting an original signed and approved release request. Photo copies are not accepted.

Please download the Player Financial Release form and Acknowledgement of Player Movement Rules which are found at [www.liahl.com](http://www.liahl.com) and navigating to ABOUT LIAHL ! LIAHL PLAYER MOVEMENT FORMS ! PARENTS FORM.

A valid release request contains Part 1 of the Player Financial Release form AND the Acknowledgement of Player Movement Rules form filled out completely, and mailed with a self addressed stamped envelope to the following address – do not mail them to the Arrows Post Office box or any other address. I will use the email address included on the Release Request form to let you know if you have not followed these instructions so please make sure it is clearly written.

Please allow for sufficient time for your approved release to be returned to you prior to the tryout you are looking to have your child attend. The Arrows have the right to reject any release request postmarked after April 6, 2017. Again, release requests will not be accepted by hand or through any other means of delivery other than via the US Postal Service. Should you fail to complete all of Part 1, or fail to include a Self Addressed Stamped Envelope, the processing of your request will be delayed.

Be aware that the use of Premium Postal Service features such as "Return Receipt Requested" or "Registered Mail" may actually result in delays in turning around your request. After you receive your release, I strongly urge you to review and fully understand the Player Movement Rules. Violation, intentional or otherwise can result in disciplinary action, including but not limited to suspension of your child from participating on an LIAHL team for all or part of the new season.

Photocopies of the release will NOT be accepted by any organization at tryouts. If you wish to back out of an organization's tryout at anytime you may do so and request that your release form be returned. Please keep in mind that the organization is under no obligation to return any tryout fees to you in whole or in part if you choose to back out, nor accept you back on their tryout ice if you should come back on a subsequent tryout date after having backed out.

Release requests received after the deadline stated above may be denied, as it is the Arrows prerogative. A denied release request may be appealed to the NYSAHA Eastern Zone President. I hope that you and your child enjoyed your membership in the Arrows this season and I thank you on behalf of the entire Board of Directors for choosing our organization.
